Continuing on from the previous two successful biennial state weeds conferences, WMSSA would like to invite speakers interested in weeds, weed management and weed research to submit abstracts for the up-coming South Australian Weeds Conference.

- Weed management for biodiversity

Abstracts and summaries should be a maximum of 300 words. The title should be in bold Times New Roman, 12 point type, centred and the author list should be in standard Times New Roman, 9 point, centred. The content should be in standard Times New Roman, 9 point type, left justified.

All abstracts will be compiled for conference attendees but should you wish to submit a full written paper for inclusion with the conference abstracts then they must be submitted by April 4th 2012. Full papers will only be accepted on receipt of an abstract by the due date of February 17th 2012. Full papers must be submitted in the same format as abstracts. You will be notified of the acceptance of your presentation for inclusion in the conference by March 5th 2012.

Posters and displays are also welcome and encouraged. Those intending to present a poster or display should notify Susan Ivory or Shauna Potter (contact details below) by February 17th 2012. An A4 representation of your poster can be included in the conference proceedings if provided by April 4th 2012.
